The Red Bluff Bull Sale Committee would like to invite you to take part in the 2019 Red Bluff Gelding Sale. The 2018 sale was a fantastic success averaging \$11,872 on 65 geldings. 36 lots brought \$10,000 or more, 15 lots \$15,000 plus, and 6 over \$20,000. Two Geldings sold for \$30,000! Over the past ten years our top selling horse has averaged over \$27,000!

New for 2019 we are introducing an invitational two-year old class. We will be selecting ten, two-year old geldings from those submitted. These young geldings will be shown and sold in the halter and sold as unbroken, untrained prospects. They will not be ridden during any of our previews or the sale itself. Those who are interested in participating can enter their young gelding and email a short video displaying his conformation. Those who are chosen will participate in the sift and a modified dry work and sell in a special section during the Gelding Sale. See special section in the entry rules for complete details.

The Consignor of the "**Top Cow Horse**", the highest scoring horse from the stock horse and snaffle bit/hackamore classes, will again take home a check for **\$7500!** We are **limiting our entries to 100 Geldings plus 10 two-year olds.** Horses not entered in classes will sell in the order their entry was received *after* all contest horses have sold, so get your entries in early. The calf branding and team roping previews offer a chance to showcase your horse for an entry fee of \$100 to cover cattle costs and to ensure serious participants only.

We have made arrangements with **Zoetis** to add value to your consignment with their innovative **Immune Support Guarantee** program. Following the vaccination protocols of the **Zoetis ISG program** will give the buyer the confidence that the horse they are bidding on has been properly immunized. If for some reason it does fall ill, they will not be on the hook for a vet bill on the horse they just purchased. To enroll your horse in the ISG program you must have your vet give immunizations and complete the enclosed affidavit.

The cutting and stock horse classes each have **\$3000 added** money, the snaffle bit, **\$2000.** Each class is jackpotted and pays three slots. \$1000 each to the heading and heeling champions. The Craig Owens Ideal Ranch Horse and the Conformation Champion will also receive \$1000 prizes. All told an impressive \$12,000 in added/prize monies not counting the jackpots or the Top Cow Horse Money.

Please send in two good photos of each consignment. We will choose one to print in the catalog and post both photos in our Internet catalog. Lots without photos receive much less attention online. Make sure the horse is in the foreground of the photo, as we will not be editing your pictures.

Red Bluff is a great place to sell a good gelding. It is not a great place to sell a problem horse. Our buyers come prepared to bid and expect a horse to live up to the comments printed in the catalog. It has been my experience that when a buyer is not happy it is almost always a gelding that should have been sold privately. Unhappy buyers are bad for Red Bluff and bad for you. Be confident that your consignment will make someone happy.

Entries close November 15, or upon reaching **100 geldings.** Please take the time to thoroughly review the rules and regulations. Keep in mind, folks will be judging you and your program based on what they see you bring to Red Bluff. Consigning your best geldings will lead to calls throughout the year. RULES AND REGULATIONS

GELDINGS MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS AND CHECKED IN AT THE GELDING OFFICE BY 11:00 A.M., Wednesday, January 23, 2019. (Gelding office is located in the Pauline Davis Pavilion.)

NO OUTSIDE HORSES OR DOGS ARE ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS.
NO EXCEPTIONS!

Only consignments of Registered Quarter GELDINGS, American Paint Horse Association, or American Quarter Horse Association Appendix Registered horses will be accepted.
We will be accepting solid colored, registered paint horse geldings.

All horses must be three to twelve years of age at sale time. Age will be based on January 1st.

Entries are limited to five horses per consignor. This includes horses represented or acting as an agent. Entries will be accepted as they arrive in the office. Entries limited to the first 100 horses consigned. If the limit of 100 geldings is reached before November 15, 2018, entries will close. (Entries received after closing will be returned by mail.) No phone or verbal entries accepted.

Original Registration Papers, Signed Transfers, Photos and Entry Fees MUST accompany entries. YOUR ENTRY WILL BE RETURNED IF NOT COMPLETE. All horses must have an AQHA or APHA registration number at time of entry. Entered horses must match the registration papers. All horses must be entered in the name of the owner as it appears on the registration paper. No double transfers!

This is an Invitational sale. The sale management reserves the right to refuse entries that, in their opinion, are not up to sale quality. The sale management reserves the right to refuse entries from individual consignors.

Entry fees are \$220.00 PER GELDING ENTERED. Entry fee is non refundable. **Sale commission is 8% of the gross sale on all lots grossing \$14,999 or less, 7% of the gross sale on all lots grossing \$15,000 or more.** Payment on consignment will be mailed no later than 14 days from the date of sale. Consignment checks will be made payable to registered owner unless a written statement is filed stating otherwise. Consignor will be charged \$20.00 for a new halter and lead rope, to be given to the new owner at the time of sale. This charge will be deducted from your consignment's gross sale.

Original coggins test and Health Certificate will be required at time of check-in. All horses must have a coggins test done within 6 months of sale. (No testing will be done at the sale. Blood tests are run at the State lab and require one to two weeks to get results.)

ALL GELDINGS:

- MUST HAVE BEEN GELDED AT LEAST 60 DAYS PRIOR TO THE SALE.
- Will not be sifted for having long hair.
- Must be freshly shod at sale time.
- No hoof black or any other hoof color may be used on sale horses.
- Any suspicious tails are subject to an electromyograph.
- Are required to be ridden, shown and sold with two cinches. (Front and rear cinches.)
- Must be shown in the same bit/mouthpiece in the sale ring as they are previewed in. There will be a judge checking equipment.
- All geldings must be vaccinated for the West Nile Virus and a Flu Vaccine. If you want your gelding enrolled in the Zoetis ISG program at Red Bluff (see flyer included), your veterinarian must give the shots and the ISG Certificate must be submitted to the office before the sale.

All geldings will be inspected for quality and condition, visible unsoundness, structural problems or unsoundness affecting future soundness. Only geldings sound in eyes and wind will be sold. No parrot mouthed geldings will be sold. Any gelding missing a permanent tooth or any dental abnormalities will be sifted. Geldings with minor cuts, abrasions, sores, etc. may be allowed to sell if, in the opinion of the sift committee, it is likely to heal normally without veterinary treatment and poses no long-term threat to the value or usefulness of the horse. The committee will be performing a drug screen on all geldings. Any gelding showing the effects of drugs or medications will be automatically sifted from the sale. Any gelding can and may be sifted at any time prior to the sale at the committee's discretion. All fees are forfeited on sifted geldings.

Sifting will be Thursday January 24 at 8:00 am. Starting with the 2 year olds.

The following rules will govern the sifting committee inspection:

- All horses will be shown at halter.
- Handlers must show horse's hind feet may easily be picked up.
- All horses (except two-year olds) will be bridled in front of the sifting committee.
- Handlers will move their horses in a manner prescribed by the sifting committee.

All geldings that pass Thursday mornings halter sift, will work under saddle at 1:00 pm. The arena will be split into thirds, you will enter the south end and dry work (1 1/2 minutes), then go to the center pen and complete the trail obstacles (open and close a gate, walk overs, back up, side pass, drag a log, remove a slicker, etc.), then finish in the north end with the cattle work. If you choose not to work a cow, you will dry work again.

Sign up for cattle works in the office at check-in on Wednesday. The \$20.00 cattle fee will be deducted from your consignment check.

All GELDINGS passed by the committee must sell Friday January 25 beginning at 6:00 pm. The sale will be held in the Pauline Davis Pavilion.

RV hook-ups are available for \$150.00 for the week of the sale. Water and power.

Two (2) passes will be given per gelding consigned. Additional tickets may be purchased at the sale for \$15 each.

Invitational Two-Year Old Class:

Two-year old Class will be governed by the Gelding Sale rules with the following exceptions:

- Committee will select ten to be accepted.
- Consignments must be two years old, foaled between January 1 and May 1.
- Feet must be trimmed.
- Will be sold as un-started.
- Will not be mounted by a rider at any time during the sift, dry work or sale.
- Must demonstrate ability to be led and lunged during drywork.
- Will sell in random order in special section of sale.
- Two-year old will not count towards five head limit.
- Email a short video showing conformation of entry to tjsuther@frontiernet.net

Sale Order: All lots competing in stock horse, cutting or snaffle bit/hackamore class, but not placing, will sell by random draw in the front of the sale. Champion Conformation, Craig Owens Ideal Ranch Horse, and first, second, and third place in the stock horse, snaffle bit/hackamore cutting, and Roping classes will sell in predetermined slots interspersed in the front of the sale. After all geldings entered in classes have sold, lots not entered in classes will sell in the order their entries were received. **Note-** Consignors with multiple lots not entered in classes may sell consecutively.

Buy Back/No Sales: All geldings passing the sift will be entered in the auction. No lot may be “passed out” or “no sold” by the consignor. Full commission will be due at the announced sale price for all lots, no exceptions. No auctioneer or other sale staff shall have any role in “flooring” any lots. No auctioneer or other sale staff shall accept bids from any individual bidding from within the sale ring or warm up pen. All bidders must have registered for a buyer’s number and be ready to provide that number when bidding. Winning bidders name will be announced after the gavel drops and will appear on the printed sale results.

Team Roping: Friday, January 25, following the classes. \$100 cattle fee. Please check box on entry to enter. The Champion Head and Heel Horse will each receive \$1000.00.

Calf Branding: Friday, January 25, following Team Roping. \$100.00 cattle fee. Please check box on entry to enter.

The Stock Horse and Snaffle Bit entries **may cross enter** the Ranch Cutting class. \$3000.00 added money in the Stock Horse and Ranch Cutting classes. \$2000.00 added money to the Snaffle Bit class. The Ranch Cutting, Snaffle Bit and Stock Horse classes will begin at 8:00am Friday morning. The Champions receive prize money and champion jackets. Each class pays 3 places, 50%, 30%, 20%.

For 2019 the Top Cow Horse will be guaranteed a \$7,500 payout. The Top Cow Horse will be the highest scoring horse from the Stock Horse and Snaffle Bit/Hackamore classes.

The Champion Conformation Horse will be selected by the committee Thursday, 7:00 pm. The winner will receive a \$1000, buckle and champion jacket.

The Craig Owens Ideal Ranch Horse will be selected by the committee following the Stock Horse class on Friday morning. The winner will receive \$1000.00, buckle and champion jacket.

PHOTOGRAPHS: All consignors must submit two(2) photographs of each horse entered with their entry, e-mail to tjsuther@frontiernet.net. This is mandatory for entry into the sale. The photos will be used in the catalog and on the Internet.

The Red Bluff Bull and Gelding Sale proudly present the 32nd Annual Hackamore/Snaffle Bit Class. The Hackamore/Snaffle Bit class will be open to three, four, and five year old horses consigned to the sale. There will be a \$200.00 entry fee. (\$180.00 to prize money, \$20.00 cattle charge.), with \$2000.00 added money. Prize money will be paid to first, second, and third (50%, 30%, 20%). In the event that the "Top Cow Horse" comes from the Snaffle Bit/Hackamore class, 1st place pays out \$7500. Only leather chin straps may be used. All bits shall be a smooth snaffle. Bits will be checked by the judges. The Hackamore/Snaffle Bit Class will be conducted Friday morning. All entrants will be asked to show their horse's ability to handle a cow. Horses entered in this class can cross enter the cutting. All entries preview on Thursday.

The rules are as follows:

1. One animal will be turned into the arena, horse and rider must box the cow at the same end of arena to show horse's cow sense. Contestant will then allow cow to run at least 2/3 length of arena, either side of arena is okay. Make one good turn each way on fence. Rider will then circle the cow both directions. There will be a 2½ minute time limit. Judges will score between 60-80.
2. Emphasis on scoring will be given to the contestant:
 - a. Maintaining control over cow at all times.
 - b. Exhibiting natural cow working ability without excessive reining or spurring.
 - c. 75% on cow, 25% on dry work.
3. Contestants shall be penalized for:
 - a. General bad manners such as biting, striking or running over the cow.
 - b. Horses that run past the cow.
 - c. Hanging up on the fence.
 - d. Exhausting the cow before circling.
 - e. Failure to hold the cow on the end.
4. At the discretion of the judges, contestant shall receive no score and have their work terminated for the following:
 - a. Turning the horse away from the cow and the fence, when the horse should properly be turning toward the cow and the fence.
 - b. Being out of control, thus endangering the rider, i.e.; crossing the path of the cow.
 - c. Running over a cow, thus causing a fall of horse or rider.
 - d. Reaching down to pull one rein on two rein horses.
5. Each entry shall work the cow drawn unless otherwise designated by the judge.
6. All horses entered in the contest will be required to perform a very limited dry work to be announced with the judge's instructions on Friday morning.

The Red Bluff Bull and Gelding Sale proudly presents the 34th Annual Stock Horse Class. The Stock Horse Class will be open to bridle horses entered in the sale. There will be a \$200.00 entry fee. (\$180.00 to prize money \$20.00 cattle charge), with \$3000.00 added money. Prize money will be paid to first, second, and third place (50%, 30%, 20%). In the event that the "Top Cow Horse" comes from the Stock Horse class, 1st place pays out \$7500. Stock horses may be shown in the bridle or two rein. Only leather chin straps may be used. All bits shall have unbroken mouthpieces. Bridles will be checked by the judges. All entrants will be asked to show their horse's ability to handle a cow. The Stock Horse Class will be conducted Friday morning. Entries may cross enter into the cutting class. All entries preview on Thursday.

The rules are as follows:

1. One animal will be turned into the arena, horse and rider must box the cow at the same end of arena to show horse's cow sense. Contestant will then allow cow to run at least 2/3 length of arena, either side of arena is okay. Make one good turn each way on fence. Rider will then circle the cow both directions. There will be a 2½ minute time limit. Judges will score between 60-80.
2. Emphasis on scoring will be given to the contestant:
 - a. Maintaining control over cow at all times.
 - b. Exhibiting natural cow working ability without excessive reining or spurring.
 - c. 75% on cow, 25% on dry work.
3. Contestants shall be penalized for:
 - a. General bad manners such as biting, striking or running over the cow.
 - b. Horses that run past the cow.
 - c. Hanging up on the fence.
 - d. Exhausting the cow before circling.
 - e. Failure to hold the cow on the end.
4. At the discretion of the judges, contestant shall receive no score and have their work terminated for the following:
 - a. Turning the horse away from the cow and the fence, when the horse should properly be turning toward the cow and the fence.
 - b. Being out of control, thus endangering the rider, i.e.; crossing the path of the cow.
 - c. Running over a cow, thus causing a fall of horse or rider.
 - d. Reaching down to pull one rein on two rein horses.
5. Each entry shall work the cow drawn unless otherwise designated by the judge.
6. All horses entered in the contest will be required to perform a very limited dry work to be announced with the judge's instructions on Friday morning.
