Dear Gelding Consignor,

The Red Bluff Bull and Gelding Sale Committee would like to invite you to take part in our 81st Anniversary of the Red Bluff Gelding Sale, January 25th-29th 2022. We would like to give a huge **Thank You** to our long time Exclusive Gelding sponsor **Rolling Hills Casino!** Their partnership and dedication to our event allows us to make Red Bluff Gelding Sale the premier event that it is today. When making your travel arrangements for Red Bluff check out the fabulous accommodations at **Rolling Hills Casino!** The 2021 Sale was a fantastic success averaging \$19,006! We had 33 lots that brought \$10,000 or more, we had 21 lots bring \$15,000 plus and 11 lots sold over \$20,000! 2021 High Seller brought \$47,000!

The invitational two-year old class was another huge success with 10 consignments averaging \$12,750. We will once again be selecting ten, two-year old geldings from those submitted. These young geldings will be shown and sold in the halter and sold as unbroken, untrained prospects. They will not be ridden during any of our previews or the sale itself. Those who are interested in participating can enter their young gelding and email a short video displaying his conformation. Those who are chosen will participate in the sift and a modified dry work and sell in a special section during the Gelding Sale. See special section in the entry rules for complete details.

The Consignor of "**The Top Cow Horse**", the highest scoring horse from the Stock Horse and Snaffle Bit/ Hackamore classes, will again take home a check for **\$7,500!** We are **limiting our entries to 100 geldings plus 10 two-year olds.** Horses not entered in classes will sell in random draw order after all contest horses have sold. The Calf Branding and Team Roping previews offer a chance to showcase your horse for an entry fee of \$100 to cover cattle costs and to ensure serious participants only. In addition to these two disciplines we will also be offering a Breakaway Roping entry as well for the same cattle charge of \$100.

The Cutting and Stock Horse classes each have **\$3000 added money**, the Snaffle Bit has **\$2000 added money.** Each class is jackpotted and pays three slots. \$1000 each to the Heading and Heeling Champions. The Craig Owens Ideal Ranch Horse and the Conformation Champion will also receive \$1000 purses. All together an impressive **\$12,000 in added money** not counting the jackpots or the Top Cow Horse money.

Please send in two good photos of each consignment. We will choose one to print in the Catalog and post both photos in our internet catalog. Lots without photos receive much less attention online than those with. Make sure the horse is in the foreground of the photo, as we will not be editing your submissions. Once again this year we will be asking for short video of your consignment as well; as we will be putting in on our Red Bluff Bull Sale YouTube channel! Please like and subscribe, to follow all of the exciting things here at the Red Bluff Bull and Gelding Sale. We will be posting videos of all lot numbers previews and works during the week. This new media outlet will allow us to better advertise your consignment to potential buyers who may not be able to physically attend earlier in the week or in person at all. This video will also be available for viewing in our online catalog as well. The content of the video is your discretion, this is your opportunity to best showcase your consignment!

Red Bluff is a great place to sell a good gelding. It is not a great place to sell a problem horse. Our buyers come prepared to bid and expect a horse to live up to the comments printed in the catalog. It has been our experience that when a buyer is not happy it is almost always a gelding that should have been sold privately. We ask you to be confident that your consignment will make someone happy and make You and the Red Bluff Bull and Gelding Sale proud.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

NO DOGS will be allowed on the grounds – you will be asked to take your dog home – **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

NOTICE: MINIMUM GRADE IS 87. If the quality of your consignment does not meet the expectations of the Sale Committee, you may be asked not to return the next year.

TIME & PLACE OF EVENT: Tehama District Fairgrounds. Located one mile East of Interstate 5, Red Bluff, California. **Bulls must be on the grounds by Noon, Monday, January 24, 2022.**
Sale Time: SATURDAY, January 29, 2022 @ 9:30am.

ENTRY DEADLINE: This is an Invitational Sale. Entries close **November 10, 2021.** All fees, certificates (or photocopies), cataloging information and completed transfers must accompany entry. **Entries arriving incomplete will be returned for completion and risk not being included in the catalog.**

GENETIC DEFECTS: No carriers will be accepted. All consignors guarantee that their bulls are free of recognized genetic defects. If it is determined after the sale that a bull is a carrier, the consignor will be required to either compensate the buyer for the difference between beef value of the bull and purchase price, or return the entire purchase price to the buyer and take the bull back at his own expense. If the buyer wishes to replace the bull with another, and the consignor is willing to settle in this manner, it will be satisfactory to the Bull Sale Committee. The Red Bluff Bull Sale Committee will act as AGENT ONLY. All responsibility lies between the consignor and the buyer.

TATTOOS: All tattoos will be read upon arrival and must be clear.

HALTER SECTION: All bulls in the Halter Section will be tied without panels and will show and sell as singles. Halter bulls may be clipped. **All tie bulls must be tied with a halter and neck rope, both must be left on the bulls after the sale. Division changes must be made at time of check-in.**

RANGE READY SECTION: By approval of the Sale Manager. A separate entry form is required for Range Ready bulls. **PLEASE NOTE: NO FITTING & no adhesives on Range Ready Bulls.** Wash rack for Range Bulls will be available on grounds. Owner or handler must be present to help bring bulls into the sale ring.

CALVING EASE SECTION: Requirements are as follows: Black Angus; Birth weight 80# or less, BEPD's 1.5 or less, BEPD's of Bulls Sire and Dam must not be over 2.0. Red Angus, Birth weight 80# or less, BEPD's -1.3 or less, BEPD's of Bulls Sire and Dam must not be over -.3. Hereford (Horned & Polled), Birth weight 80# or less, BEPD's 1.5 or less, BEPD's of Bulls Sire and Dam must not be over 2.5.

SWITCHING SECTIONS: Any consignor wishing to switch a lot from one section to another may do so only with approval from management and prior to the check in deadline.

AGE LIMIT: Bulls 12 – 26 months of age at sale time will be accepted. 12 month old bulls must weigh a minimum of 1,000 #'s to be eligible for entry. No bulls over 26 months of age on January 29, 2022 will be accepted without prior approval from the Sale Manager.

ENTRY FEES: An entry fee of \$85.00 per head. **An additional \$25.00 per bull late fee will be charged on all entries received after November 10, 2021.** Payment on consignment will be mailed no later than 14 days from the date of sale. **All paperwork must be in the bull sale office to receive payment on the consignments.**

COMMISSION FEES: A commission of 7% of gross sale for halter bulls and range bulls will be deducted from each consignment.

PRODUCTION INFORMATION: Any bona fide production test information should be included with the entry. Weight per day of age (WDA) will be published in Saturday's Sale Order. Please contact the sale office if you need more information regarding production information.

Each consignor will need to provide adjusted 205 weaning weight, adjusted 365 yearling weight and performance data from your breed association, for each bull consigned. It is the responsibility of the consignor to request and provide this information to the Red Bluff Bull Sale office for publication in the catalog.

E.P.D. production information will be obtained from the breed associations by the Red Bluff Bull Sale office. Updates from associations in January will not be announced.

WEIGHT PER DAY OF AGE: Bulls will be weighed for a WDA between the sifting and grading.

ENTRIES OPEN TO THE FOLLOWING BREEDS: All breeds, upon approval by Committee.

FINISH & SOUNDNESS: Preferably good service condition. Bulls which have ample exercise while being fed for sale are desired. Bulls should be able to give as much service as practical.

SELECTION OF SUPREME BULL: The Supreme Bull & Reserve Supreme Bull will be selected from the Champion Halter Bulls. Angus, Horned Hereford, Polled Hereford, or AOB. Supreme & Reserve Supreme Bull must be bred by consignor or owned a year prior to sale.

ALL BULLS CONSIGNED & NOT SIFTED: All bulls consigned and not sifted must be sold through the auction ring on sale day.

FEET TRIMMING: If you wish to trim feet, please do so no later than 60 days before sale date.

CARE TAKING: Consignors are responsible for the care of their bulls while at Red Bluff. All consignors are responsible for getting their bulls to the ring for sifting, grading and selling. Bulls arriving without handlers/caretakers will be charged \$10.00/head per day. Feed costs and bedding are additional. **Care taking must be arranged in advance of bulls arrival at the fairgrounds with the Sale Manager.**

NON-BREEDING BULL: In order to protect consignors against indiscriminate requests for refunds on bulls purchased at Red Bluff, the Sale Committee has made the following rule:

Buyers suspecting a bull purchased at Red Bluff to be a non-breeder for any reason must notify the Red Bluff Bull Sale Committee regarding such bull within 90 days of the date of sale. The committee will have an examination made by a competent veterinarian. The Committee reserves the right to call in their own veterinarian if they deem it necessary. If it is determined that the bull is a non-breeder, the consignor will be required to either compensate the buyer for the difference between beef value of the bull and purchase price, or return the entire purchase price to the buyer and take the bull back at his own expense. If the buyer wishes to replace the bull, and the consignor is willing to settle in this manner, it will be satisfactory to the Bull Sale Committee. The Red Bluff Bull Sale Committee will act as AGENT ONLY. All responsibility lies between the consignor and the buyer.

SIFTING: The Sale Committee reserves the right to bar any bull from the ring which shows any defect, disease, infection, unsoundness, or over condition which might limit its usefulness and become a source of contention later. An examination of each bull will be made by a veterinarian and three experienced commercial operators immediately preceding judging and grading to serve as a means of detecting these bulls.

SIFTED BULLS: Any bulls sifted from the sale may be sold at private treaty. In such event, the Bull Sale will not accept responsibility for the future condition or performance of such an animal. **Private treaty sales made by a consignor of bulls graded or sifted out must be made through the Sale Office.** A three percent (3%) commission will be charged on sifted bulls. Papers on sifted bulls will be mailed.

HEALTH TESTS REQUIRED: All bulls must be semen tested no earlier than 30 days before the sale. A Trichomoniasis & Brucellosis test are required. The InPouch tm (Biomed Diagnostics, Inc.) Trichomoniasis froetus test kit is a one time test and easy to use. Also this year we are requiring a negative P.I. (BVD) test. We also encourage consignors to test for Johnes. Consult your veterinarian if you have any questions.

DRUGGING OF BULLS: The use of any drugs that may mask any disease, infection, or unsoundness is prohibited. This would include any drugs such as antibiotics, and anti-inflammatory drugs. If you have a health problem, contact the official vet through the Bull Sale Office.

HEALTH FORMS: Health forms will be mailed to the consignor in early December. All requirements must be met. **Include Brite Tag or RFID Tag # on Health Certificate.** Have your veterinarian fill out and sign.

EAR TAGS: All bulls will be ear tagged with their lot number. Tags will be sent to the consignor by the Bull Sale Office in December. **Ear tags must be in the left ear.**

SIFTING & GRADING TIMES: All range ready breeds will be sifted and graded Tuesday, Jan. 25, 2022 at 9:00am. All halter bulls will be sifted and graded Wednesday, January 26, 2022 starting at 9:00am.

SALE ORDER: All bulls graded 1- will sell first. The remainder of the bulls will sell in grade order. Placing and WDA will determine the order within the grade.

RETAINED INTEREST: If you are retaining interest or semen interest in any bull this **MUST be stated on your entry form.** It must be listed in the catalog.

JUDGING COMMITTEE: Will reserve the right to grade the first and, sometimes, second place bull. Those bulls will be brought back, then placed and graded in the Championship round.

BEDDING & FEED: Straw will not be used for bedding. DO NOT BRING STRAW. **The first bedding will be provided by the Bull Sale at no charge. Additional bales of chips can be purchased on the grounds.** Feed and watering buckets must be provided by the consignors.
